You will receive at least \$500 per week before taxes but could receive more. 	<p>Government of Canada: Canada Recovery Benefit https://www.canada.ca/en/revenue-agency/services/benefits/recovery-benefit.html</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Income support to employed and self-employed individuals who are directly affected by COVID-19 and a NOT entitled to EI benefits. • Can receive \$1,000 for a 2-week period. • If the situation continues past the 2-week period, you NEED TO apply again. • You can apply up to 13 eligibility periods
<p>Government of Canada: Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB) 1-833-966-2099 https://www.canada.ca/en/revenue-agency/services/benefits/recovery-caregiving-benefit.html</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are unable to work due to having to care for your children under 12 years old or a family member who requires supervised care. • The CRCB can provide \$500 per 1-week period for up to 26 weeks. • You DO HAVE to reapply every week to continue receiving the benefit. 	<p>Government of Canada: Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB) https://www.canada.ca/en/revenue-agency/services/benefits/recovery-sickness-benefit/crsb-how-apply.html</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides \$500 per week for up to a maximum of two weeks, for workers who: Are unable to work for at least 50% of the week because they contracted COVID-19. Are self-isolated for reasons related to COVID-19. Has underlying conditions, undergoing treatments or have contracted other sicknesses that make you susceptible to COVID-19.

Private sector employers have until March 19, 2021 to apply for the benefit. • Public Sector: DO NOT NEED TO APPLY. The government is working with public sector to distribute benefit to edible workers. • Eligibility: Have worked a minimum of 300 hours during the period of October 12, 2020 to January 31, 2021 for the same employer. Work in continuing care, acute care, addictions and mental health, homecare or hospice. Be located and working in Alberta. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Private Sector Workers must: Earn \$25 per hour or less 	

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
